ECHO® Learning Series:

Approaches to Dementia Care: Building Blocks for Becoming Age-Friendly

What is ECHO[®]?

ECHO[®] is a virtual learning community offered at no cost. Participants may also be eligible for a \$250.00 incentive payment.

This all-teach, all-learn model includes a brief presentation from a subject-matter expert followed by a case study to elicit discussion and recommendations. Participants exchange information, experiences, cases, and ideas and receive feedback from other participants and the multidisciplinary hub team of content experts.

Purpose

We will focus on strategies to improve care for older adults with dementia based on the <u>4M</u> <u>framework</u>: What Matters Most, Medications, Mentation, and Mobility. These strategies will help primary care practices and other organizations deliver care aligned with the age-friendly approach. Participants will collaborate with each other and engage in ongoing learning.

- Home care agencies
- Nursing home and assisted living staff
- Community health workers

- OT, PT, SLP, social work, and behavioral health clinicians

- Flexible participation: Attend individual sessions with no commitment to sharing a case (no incentive payment).

Format

Online sessions will include a brief presentation by a dementia-care expert followed by a case discussion.
